MEMBERSHIP –

We have a total of 3178 paid bowlers (including youth) in the VPUSBC for 2016-2017 as of May 31, 2017. This does not include any additional bowlers we may have during the summer league season. However, this is a 4% decrease over the 2015-16 season. (WinLabs Report Attached)

FINANCIAL –

The account balances are included in the Financial Report in the handouts.

BVL –

Thank you to all that supported the BVL tournament this past season. Through your donations this past season VPUSBC was able to send a check in the amount of \$4767.73 to help with the needs of our veterans.

BFTC –

This season VPUSBC bowlers via the BFTC tournament, 50/50 raffles & league donations VPUSBC was able to send BFTC a check in the amount of \$5119.50.

AWARDS –

This was the first season of our new local awards program. We have learned from it and plan to make a few changes to next season to make it an even better process for our bowlers. All in all I think we accomplished one of our goals which was to recognize the lower average bowler. The 3178 bowlers in this association have received 1508 total local VPUSBC awards this season. In addition, there have been honor scores reported to USBC totaling 177 (300's and 800's). There would have been more awards but some leagues did not turn in award applications.
